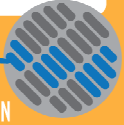

Objective: to highlight monthly activities that can be linked to stormwater pollution-prevention behaviors

Format: Bill inserts can be provided electronically (in Word and PDF) and in printed format, on a standard sheet of 8.5 x 11 paper that can be photocopied and cut in half.

The documents are created in color, but print well in black-and-white.

Use: Towns could include with already-planned town mailings such as tax bills, sewer bills, wastewater notices, etc.

Documents could be customized to use as small articles in local papers. Contact your local paper for the e-mail address to which you should send your contribution. References to local amenities, events, or issues usually help ensure that your contribution will be published.

Customizing: Towns should feel free to customize by adding their town logo, website, and/or contact information. And wherever possible, Towns could incorporate information on local water resources, protection priorities, or pollution sources.
